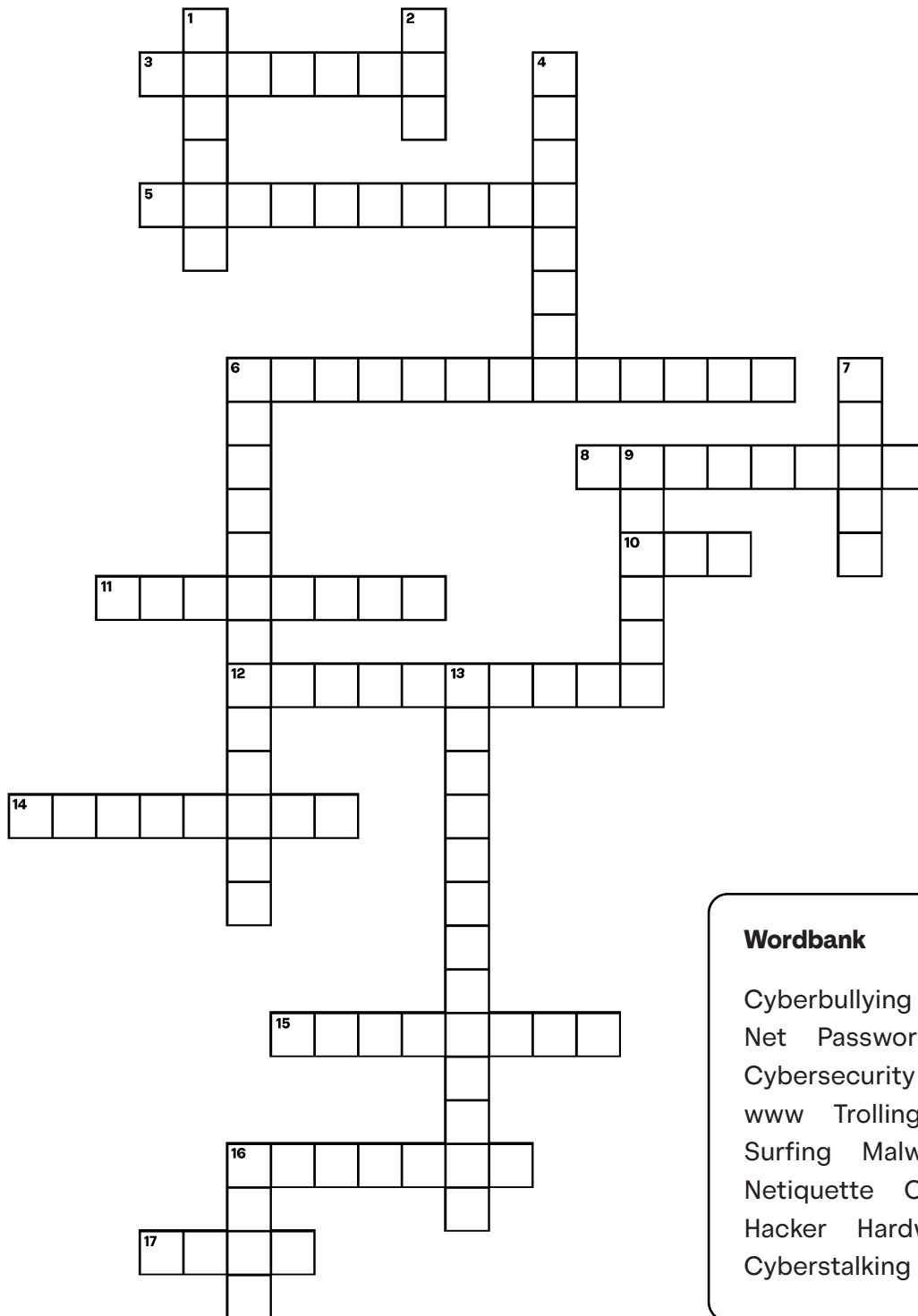


INTERNET SAFETY CROSSWORD
